Construction Tips

- Build the mailbox out of the ground, it's much easier to paint and assemble.
- Use salt-treated wood for all components. It lasts longer than untreated wood.
- Use the galvanized screws/nails for assembly. Non-galvanized screws/nails will rust quickly.



Mailbox Mounting


You may choose any mailbox mounting method. An easy and cost effective method is to nail 2 pieces of wood on top of the under slot that spans the width of the mailbox underside.


